

ACADEMY OF ADOPTION AND ASSISTED REPRODUCTION ATTORNEYS NOMINATION AND APPLICATION FOR JUDICIAL MEMBERSHIP

Thank you for your interest in nominating a member of the judiciary or nominating yourself to be a Judicial Fellow in the Academy of Adoption and Assisted Reproduction Attorneys (collectively referred to as “AAAA”). An invitation to Judicial Membership may be extended to trial or appellate judges or justices, who, in the course of performing the duties of their office, routinely consider adoption issues and adoption related matters or reproductive technology issues or related matters, or both.

Benefits of Judicial Membership include the following:

- Excellent educational opportunities in adoption law and/or assisted reproductive technology (“ART”) law through attendance at highly specialized conferences and webinars;
- Ability to interact with honorary, judicial and active practice attorneys qualified in adoption and/or ART law throughout the United States and abroad;
- Network via the AAAA Listserv and attendance at conferences;
- Access to the On-line Membership Directory to locate honorary, judicial and active practice attorneys qualified in adoption and/or ART law;
- Notification of legislation and public education efforts in adoption and/or ART;
- Coordination of legislative and public education efforts;
- Coordination of legal research;
- Notification of AAAA amicus briefs and access to brief archives;
- Support and enforcement of ethical legal practices;
- Built-in body of adoption and/or ART “advisors” via the listserv and at comprehensive and substantive conferences;
- Ability to present at “state of the art” CLE programming;
- No membership dues are required for Judicial Fellows; and
- The application fee is waived for Judicial Fellows.

The Academy Bylaws, Article IV, Section 10, set forth the requirements for Judicial Membership in either the Adoption practice section or ART practice section of AAAA:

Judicial Adoption and ART Membership requirements include the following:

- 1 . Must be a full-time trial or appellate judge or justice, who, in the course of performing the duties of his or her office, routinely consider adoption issues and adoption related matters or reproductive technology issues or related matters.
- 2 . Individuals seeking membership under this section shall provide an endorsement from at least one regular Adoption practice section member for Judicial Membership in the Adoption practice section or one regular ART practice

- section member for Judicial Membership in the ART practice section.
- 3 . A regular member who wishes to become a judicial member and who otherwise satisfies the requirements for judicial membership, may request that the Board of Trustees extend an invitation to judicial membership without the necessity of providing an endorsement from another member of AAAA.
 - 4 . Judicial membership shall continue during such member's judicial tenure unless sooner terminated by vote of the Board of Trustees.
 - 5 . Judicial members shall not be required to pay dues to AAAA.

Invitation to membership in AAAA shall be within the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees.

The AAAA President and the Board of Trustees have authorized this application process for membership in AAAA. Please complete the application carefully and follow the directions to assure prompt handling of your application. While the application at first glance may appear cumbersome, it is relatively straight-forward and user-friendly.

IMPORTANT: Please read the Academy Code of Ethics provided with this application prior to applying to AAAA. You must be in compliance with the Code and agree to remain in compliance once accepted.
